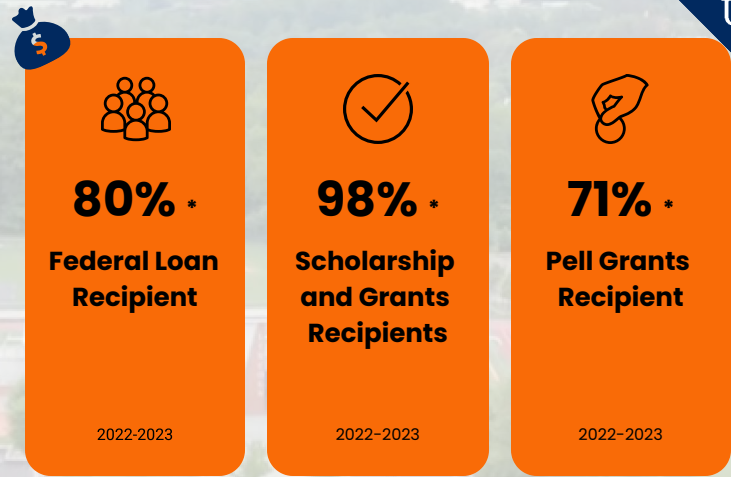

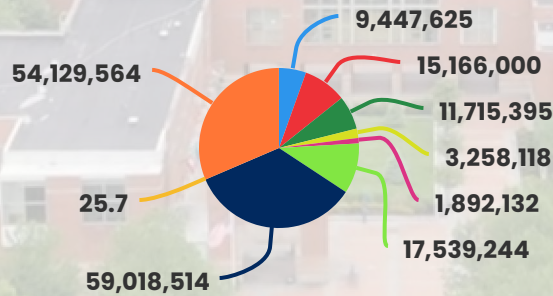

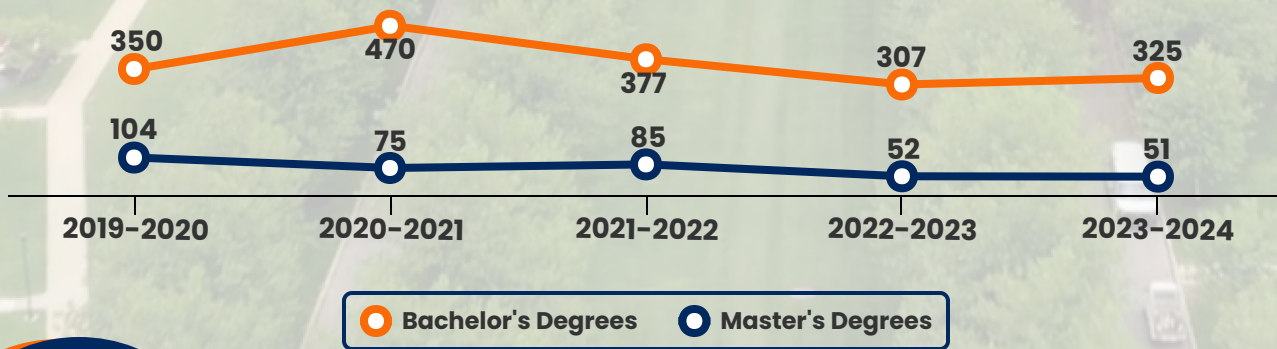

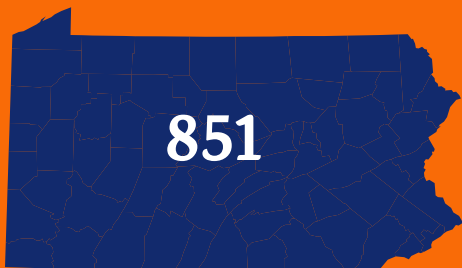

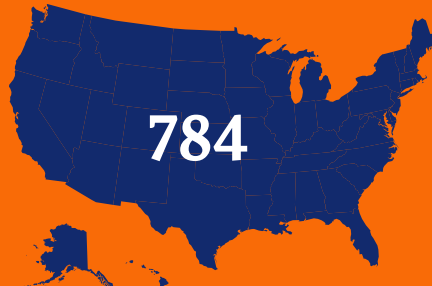


ENROLLMENT BY RESIDENCY STATUS

In-State



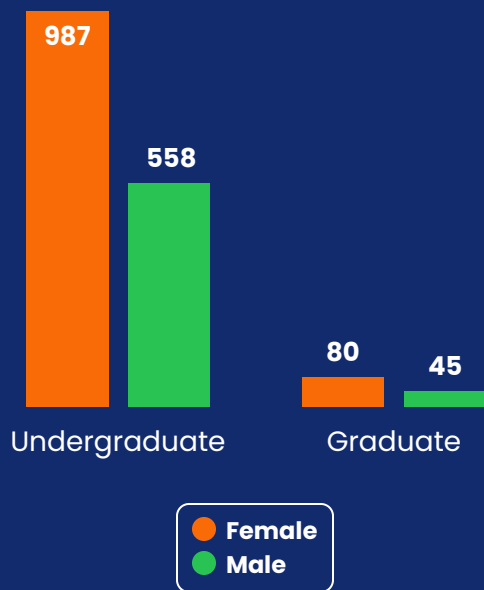
Out-of-State
