IRIS | Inclement Weather

As winter weather approaches, now is the time to sign up for the Immediate Response Information System (IRIS). It's the quickest way to keep informed when Lincoln University will begin its workday with a delayed start or close early due to inclement weather (i.e., snow, ice, ice showers, etc.). In the event of a campus emergency, our public safety personnel will use IRIS. It will be used for the dissemination of information via phone call, text or email. In order to be included in the database of contacts, you will need to register with the system. Please go to the link below and register your cell phone for text message or phone call alerts and/or your e-mail address for e-mail alerts. You may enter up to three phone numbers and two e-mail addresses.
